1. Introduction to Wix and Wix Editor

Wix is a cloud-based website builder launched in 2006, now powering millions of websites worldwide. Its flagship product, the **Wix Editor**, is a drag-and-drop tool that enables users to design websites visually without any programming knowledge. It offers:

- An intuitive drag-and-drop interface

Adding Pages

Page Settings

Click the three dots next to each page to:

- Rename
- Set SEO metadata (title, description)
- Hide from menu
- Set as homepage
- Duplicate or delete

Organizing Pages

Text

- Click **Add > Text** to insert headings, paragraphs, or custom text boxes.
- Customize fonts, sizes, colors, line spacing, and alignment via the text toolbar.

Images

- Upload your own images or choose from Wix's free media library.
- Edit images with cropping, filters, brightness, contrast, and frames.
- Use **Image Galleries** to showcase multiple photos in stylish layouts.

Buttons

- Add call-to-action buttons (e.g., Buy Now, Contact Us).
- Customize shape, color, hover effects, and link destinations.

Other Elements

- **Videos:** Embed YouTube, Vimeo, or upload your own.
 - **Shapes & Lines:** Use for decorative or structural purposes.
 - **Social Icons:** Link to your social media profiles.
 - **Lists & Menus:** Create navigation menus or content lists.

6. Using Sections and Strips for Layout Control

What Are Sections?

Sections are vertical blocks that group related content (text, images, buttons) into manageable parts of the page.

What Are Strips?

Strips are full-width horizontal containers that help organize content and add background colors or images that span the entire page width.

How to Use Them

- Add strips via **Add > Strip**.
 - Customize background colors, images, or videos for strips.
 - Add columns inside strips for multi-column layouts.
 - Move or duplicate strips to rearrange your page quickly.

7. Designing Your Site's Visual Style

Site Theme

Go to **Site Design > Theme Manager** to select or customize your site's color palette and font sets. This ensures consistent branding.

Backgrounds

Set page or strip backgrounds using solid colors, gradients, images, or videos.

Custom Fonts

Upload your own fonts to maintain brand identity.

Animations and Effects

Add entrance animations to elements (fade, slide, zoom) and scroll effects (parallax, reveal) to create engaging user experiences.

8. Adding Interactive Features and Apps

Wix App Market

Access hundreds of apps to add functionality such as:

- Contact forms
- Booking systems
- Live chat
- Event calendars
- Online stores
- Email marketing

Adding a Form

- Go to **Add > Contact & Forms**.
 - Choose a form template and customize fields.
 - Connect form submissions to your email or Wix CRM.
